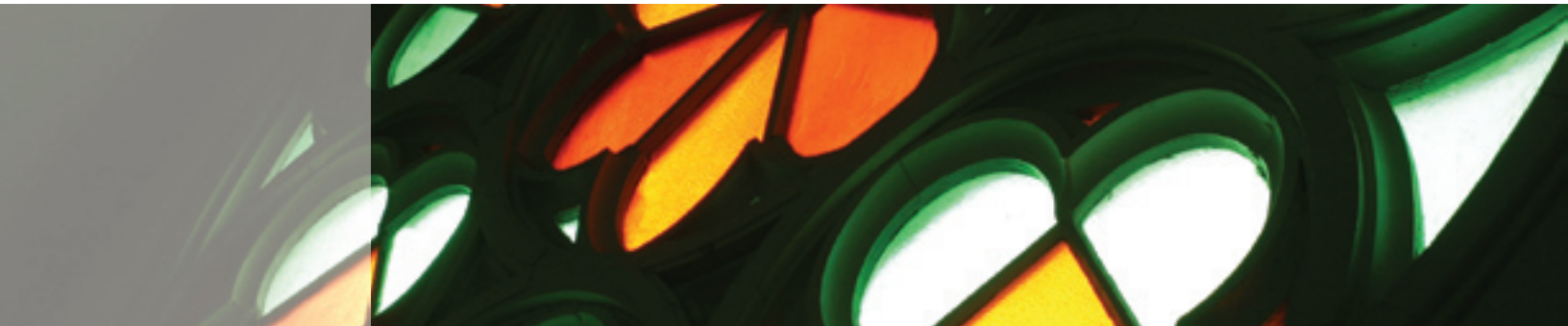

# letter from the president

Since 1885, generations of students at St. Edward's University have benefited from an innovative learning community inspired by tradition. Curricular innovation has been essential to the university's response to historical changes in society, as the world has progressed from the industrial age to a post-industrial age and a technology-driven economy. Innovation is part of the fiber of St. Edward's, something that stems from its founding on the Texas frontier and its Holy Cross mission, which calls for the courage to take risks.

At St. Edward's, tradition has always guided innovation. In the liberal arts tradition, students are steeped in the knowledge of the great minds that have influenced civilization. Equally important, they learn how to question, probe and explore so they may acquire and evaluate knowledge that will aid them in their careers and as they serve their communities.

# generations innovation&tradition

A liberal arts education, of course, includes the learning of civic virtue. However, as a Holy Cross, Catholic university, St. Edward's reaches beyond this goal and seeks to graduate men and women who have experienced the moral and spiritual awakening that comes from the personal and academic exploration of religious perspectives.

The Holy Cross tradition inspires our present and future as we seek national recognition among the best small universities in the country. In Fall 2003, we had occasion to celebrate several milestones on that journey.

- *U.S. News & World Report* ranked St. Edward's in the top tier of master's-granting universities in the West.

- St. Edward's exceeded the national average in five benchmark areas in the National Survey of Student Engagement.
- The Council of Independent Colleges selected St. Edward's as a founding institution for its national project, Foundations of Excellence in the First Year of College.
- *ABC World News Tonight* aired a feature story on the 30<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the university's College Assistance Migrant Program.
- Trustee Hall, the university's newest academic building, was featured in *Architectural Record*, the nation's leading architectural trade journal.

- St. Edward's welcomed its largest-ever freshman class of 546 students.

Particularly impressive has been the growth in financial support of the university. Indeed, St. Edward's has set new philanthropic records over the past two years — an accomplishment that earned the university a 2003 Circle of Excellence award for overall improvement in fundraising from the Council for Advancement and Support of Education (CASE). Trustee-directed giving has been central to this accomplishment, providing more than \$16 million since 2001. The St. Edward's faculty and staff also have set fundraising records. More than 83 percent contributed to the 2003 Faculty and Staff Campaign, and 23 of 54 departments achieved



100 percent participation. As fundraising for institutional priorities reached \$39.4 million in Fall 2003, St. Edward's received its largest single gift — \$7.5 million from the estate of John Brooks Williams to fund a new facility for the natural sciences. The \$20 million John Brooks Williams Natural Sciences Center has been designed by Moore Ruble Yudell Architects & Planners of Santa Monica, California, and construction will begin soon. The momentum continues to build at St. Edward's, and as this report goes to press in early 2004, fundraising has reached \$42.2 million.

It is an exciting time to be part of the St. Edward's community. Through your generosity, the university has enhanced the lives of thousands of students. Those

of you who support St. Edward's University embrace the Holy Cross philosophy of giving, which reminds us that the more we give, the more we stand to receive. Whether you live the university's mission in your daily work, volunteer your time and wise council, or generously pledge your financial support, your gifts are ensuring the future of St. Edward's as one of our nation's premier small universities.

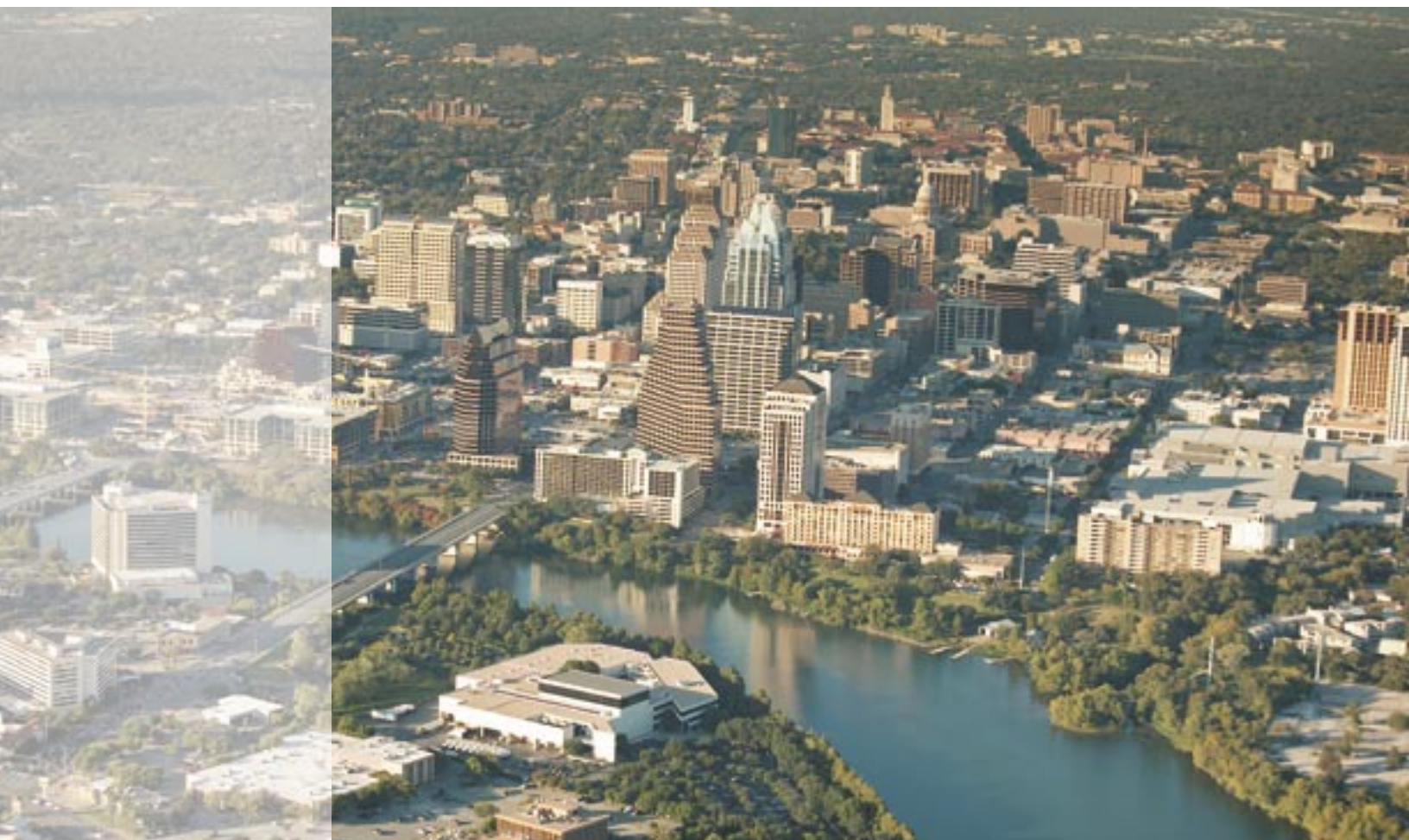
## innovation **student** publications

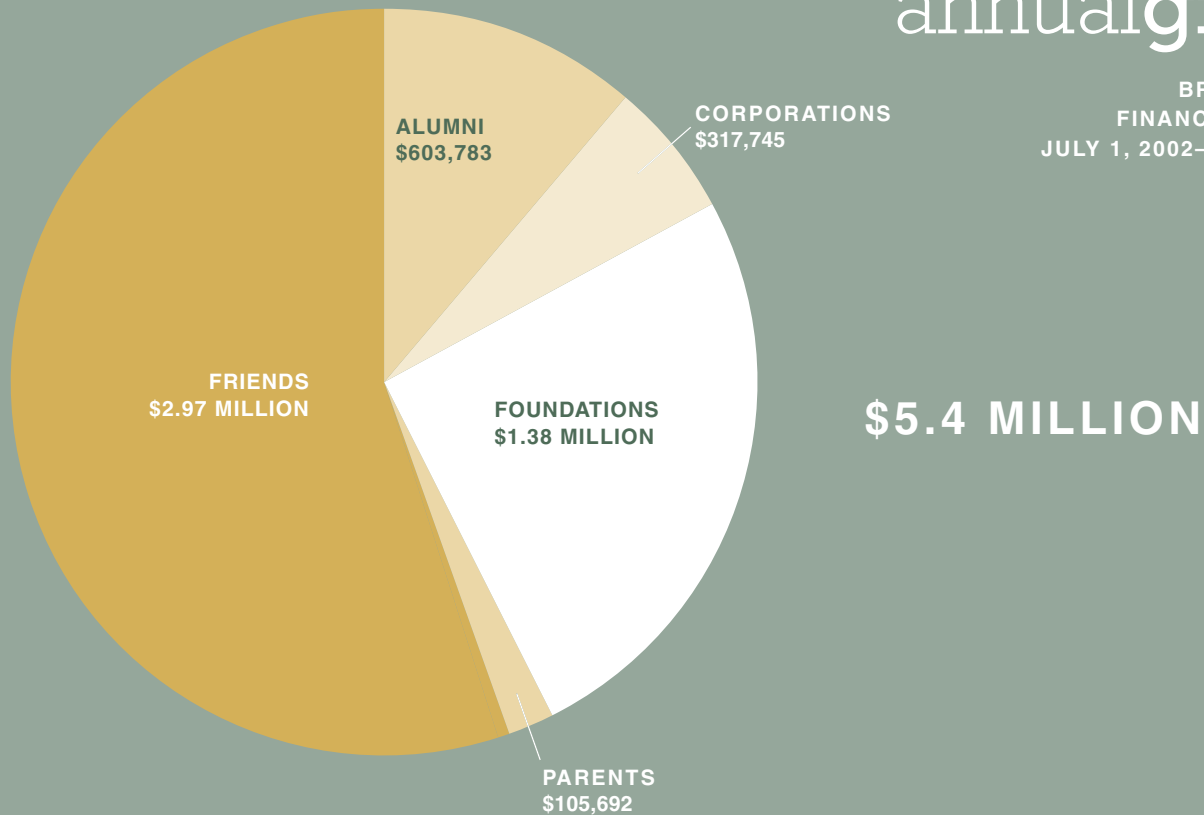

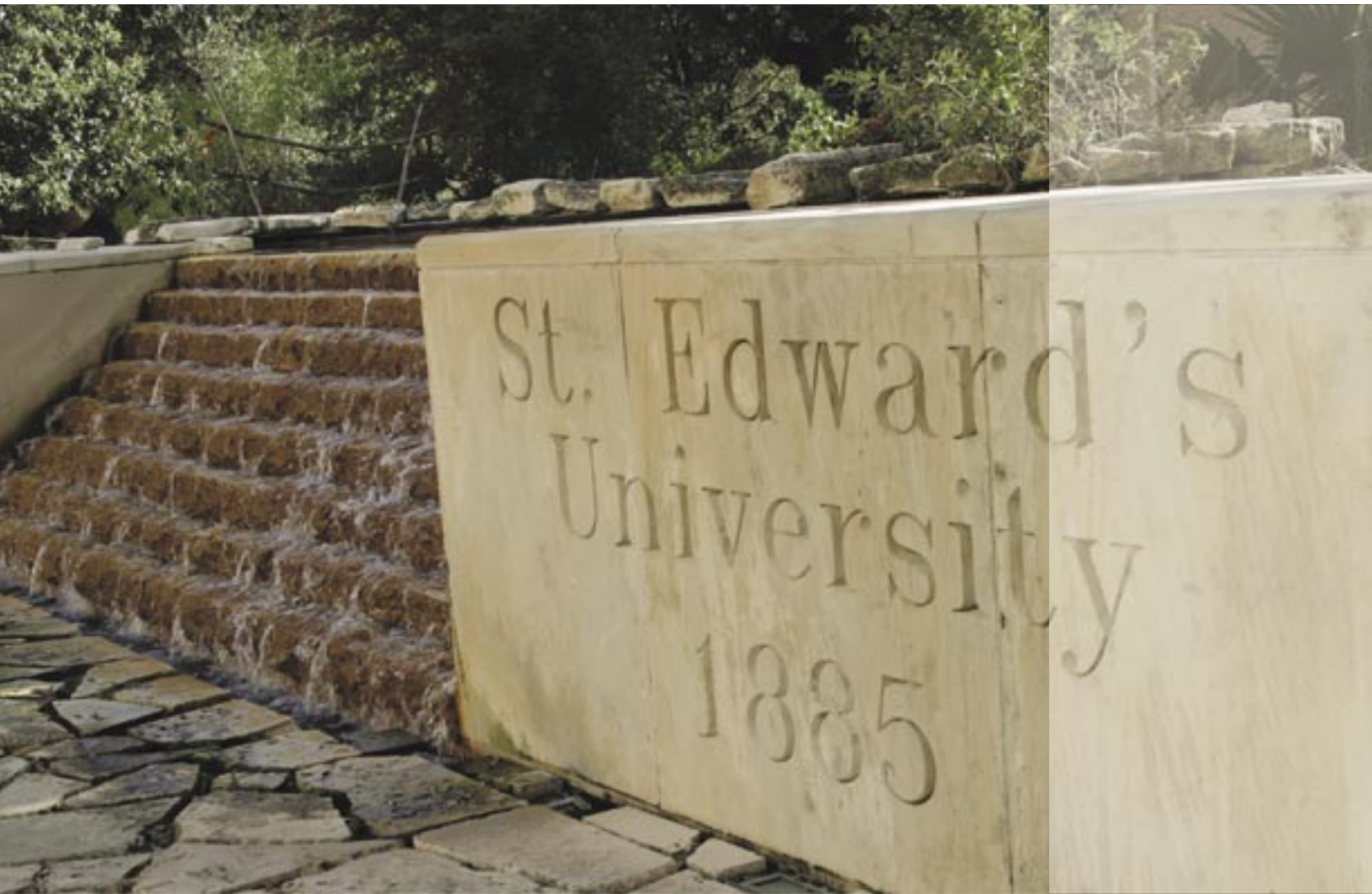
