A tremendous outpouring from university alumni, friends and family gave St. Edward's the fortitude to reach new heights.

Last year, as in so many others, St. Edward's had the courage to take risks, pursue ambitious goals, and create innovative programs. We achieved the *U.S. News and World Report* ranking among the top 25 master's-granting institutions in the western half of the United States for the fifth consecutive year. We secured \$7.3 million in total gifts and pledges — a 29 percent increase over fiscal year 2007. We also benefitted from countless hours of volunteer support. The courage for such pursuits is inspired by our Holy Cross heritage and is greatly bolstered each year by the time, counsel and financial support we receive from the university community.

This tremendous outpouring from university alumni, friends and family gave the administration, faculty and staff of St. Edward's the fortitude to reach new heights in our Holy Cross mission to transform the hearts and minds of our students. Because of this support, the university had ...

... the courage to launch new initiatives overseas. This year St. Edward's established a campus in Angers, France, created the Global Business Education and Social Justice Institute, and explored opportunities for academic partnerships in Bahrain.

... the courage to grow enrollment and maintain our small community feel. As the university welcomed 743 new students — the largest freshmen class in its history — we also hired more faculty members to maintain personal classrooms.

... the courage to expand the local reach of the university's classrooms through an affiliation with Wild Basin Wilderness Preserve in west Austin, creating a living natural resource laboratory that can be used by students and faculty members of all disciplines.

... the courage to compete against other institutions for grants such as the \$100,000 Wal-Mart Success Award, given to only 20 colleges nationwide. It lets us implement a four-week Summer Bridge for First-Generation College Success.

Lewis and Chen have set a standard of giving for their children, Stephen '07 and Elizabeth '10.

Before we ever set foot in school, we've already been to a place of learning — our homes. Families can be classrooms that teach us how to think, how to feel and how to care. A number of families with roots in St. Edward's teach their children another lesson: how to give.

Regina Lewis and **Joseph Chen** have set a standard of giving for their children, **Stephen '07** and **Elizabeth '10**. "We are proud to donate because we believe everyone at the university takes pride in its distinguishing characteristics," says Lewis, who has contributed to women's soccer and the John Brooks Williams Natural Sciences Center. "The president, faculty, administration and coaches all have the courage to take risks, and they are committed to providing educational opportunities for students of all backgrounds."

Guy hs '64, '68 and **Sherron Bodine** know all about those opportunities. Guy, a trustee emeritus, served on the board for 12 years and was chair from 1991 to 1994. They have supported St. Edward's for many years. "We give to St. Edward's because we identify with the university's mission and its focus on the individual — and more specifically on the individual thinker," says Guy. "You give when you believe your gift, whether time, talent or financial resources, will be appreciated and used for a greater good. We believe St. Edward's and its Holy Cross mission absolutely contribute to the greater good."

Providing opportunities for others inspires their own children to carry on the tradition of philanthropy.

"Our children watched what we have been able to do and began giving their time and talent to causes that were important to them at an early age," says Guy. "By virtue of their circumstances they have had the opportunity to make a difference."

Lewis has seen the same awareness sparked in her children. "We believe the endeavors we support have purpose — and we hope our children can see that purpose beyond its monetary value," she says. "Then, they too can spread that purpose to the next generation."

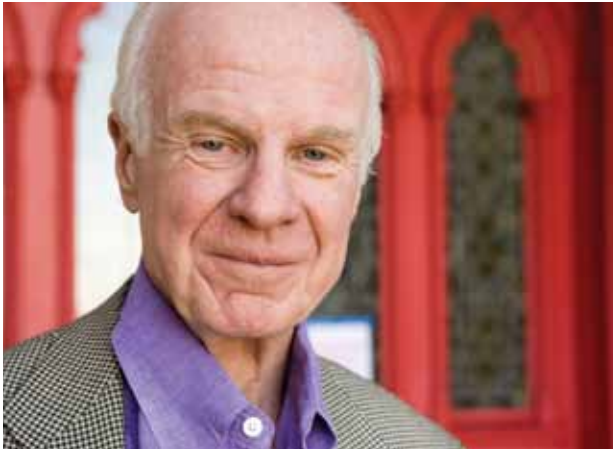

George, an assistant professor of Business Administration, has set an inspiring example to students by supporting St. Edward's outside the classroom as a member of the President's Associates.

Assistant Professor of Business Administration **Thomas George** has practiced law for more than three decades, has served as an adjunct professor at the University of Texas School of Law and School of Business, taught medical jurisprudence for medical students at University of Texas Medical Branch, and is presently completing his PhD from the Institute for the Medical Humanities/UTMB. He has also worked as a mediator. And with specialties in civil trial law, business law and health care, he's seen quite a few scandals shake those industries to their core over the years: junk bonds, insider trading and subprime mortgages, to name just a few.

That's why teaching in the MBA and Master of Arts in Counseling programs at St. Edward's is such a breath of fresh air — he gets the opportunity to help students identify ethical dilemmas in their fields and learn to respond to them in a moral way. In his classes, George introduces the laws, regulations and ethical framework needed to make sound legal and business decisions. He also uses case studies to examine some weighty social issues, everything from end-of-life care and euthanasia to genetic testing and treatment.

“I have been involved in litigation for many years on complex issues, and it is particularly useful and productive and gratifying to teach at a university that encourages an ethical life,” says George. “In regard to the practice of law, that component is essential.”

The university's focus on helping students lead ethical lives is also the reason George supports St. Edward's outside the classroom. Since 1998, he has been a consistent member of the President's Associates, supporters who make annual gifts of at least \$1,000.

“I give to St. Edward's because I think the university provides a genuine, important service to education and the community,” he says. “Contributions from individuals who are interested in providing financial support help St. Edward's fulfill its mission, and the result is a vibrant university that genuinely contributes to an ethical business environment.”

Kelliher, dean of the School of Management and Business, helped launch the campus site in Angers, France, through the collaboration of many people, including Patier, general manager of the St. Edward's University Association (France). Back in Austin, Kelliher and others also created the Global Business Education and Social Justice Institute.

An international perspective — those words from the university's mission add up to a big challenge for the professors charged with imparting the idea to students. But the job just got a little easier, thanks to two initiatives launched this fall: a new campus site in Angers, France, and the Global Business Education and Social Justice Institute.

In Angers, St. Edward's has created a spectrum of educational programs, some of them provided in partnership with the Université Catholique de l'Ouest, one of France's most prestigious Catholic colleges, and high school Institut Bois-Robert. Part of the university's Global Understanding Initiative, the France collaboration earned St. Edward's the Best Investment in Europe Award at the World Investment Conference in June. In addition, a partnership with Apple will allow St. Edward's to offer customized professional education curriculum.

"For American students, this project is a way to feel connected with European culture," says Jean-Marie Patier, the principal of Bois-Robert. "For Bois-Robert, it gives us a chance to prepare young Europeans to enroll in a very attractive and high-level academic program at St. Edward's. What's more, this program develops the open-mindedness of all the teams who are part of the project."

Across the globe, St. Edward's launched the Global Business Education and Social Justice Institute, initiated through a \$100,000 grant from the RGK Foundation. For the institute's first project, graduate and undergraduate business students from St. Edward's are lending their skills to Casa Luz, a nonprofit that helps teen mothers in San Jose, Costa Rica. Both abroad and on campus, students are working with the nonprofit to enhance existing enterprises, craft a fundraising plan and investigate relevant economic issues.

"We liked the idea that the institute was anchored in addressing real-world challenges using socially responsible solutions and innovative, international coursework with direct faculty leadership," says Greg Kozmetsky '70, RGK's president. "We hope the students involved personally experience the people, culture, history, language, politics and geography while assisting the community in mutually solving an important issue, thereby making a lasting difference in the lives of those they touch."

Böer created the August Böer and Lena Böer Endowed Scholarship.

A professor of Entrepreneurship at Vanderbilt University, he sees scholarships as an investment to help ensure the value of a university as well as give them support.

Think of it as start-up capital. Like businesses that need seed money to get off the ground, students benefit from the money of a scholarship to help them complete their college education. As two alumni who teach entrepreneurship at universities, **Germain Böer '60** and **Ray Smilor '69** are familiar with the needs of start-up companies as well as students. That's why they've started scholarships at St. Edward's.

Böer, who teaches Entrepreneurship in the Owen Graduate School of Management for Vanderbilt University, recently established The August Böer and Lena Böer Endowed Scholarship. He named the scholarship in honor of his parents, who never made it to high school but who encouraged their son to pursue higher education.

A former accountant for Arthur Andersen & Co. who moved into teaching Entrepreneurship after years on the Business faculties of universities, Böer talks about his scholarship in the way of an investor concerned about the overall value of a company.

"Being at a university, I know that the more scholarship money a school has, the more choices it has for the variety and quality of students it can bring in," he says.

Similarly, Smilor, executive director of the Beyster Institute at the Rady School of Management at the University of California at San Diego, wanted to help ensure St. Edward's could continue providing the same opportunities he enjoyed at the university. He and his wife, Judy '71, created two scholarships: The Raymond and Judy Smilor Family Endowed Scholarship and The Michael Cinal '69 Memorial Endowed Scholarship, the latter named for a classmate who died unexpectedly.

A noted speaker and author on entrepreneurship, Smilor likes to see the return on his investment — in the form of letters from students who get one of his scholarships. "It's marvelous to know someone is getting the benefit," he says. "I tell them to remember when you're successful in the future, you have an obligation to give something back."

As a member of the Young Alumni Council, Gutierrez helps young alumni like herself maintain their connection to the university.

A recent survey of 3,000 young alumni by Alumni and Parent Programs found that as much as they prefer staying connected online, it's good old-fashioned faculty interaction that they miss about St. Edward's.

Forging such friendships is something young alumna **Victoria Gutierrez '00, MLA '04** knows well. One week before she graduated with a BA, her father unexpectedly passed away. The overwhelming support from professors helped her cope with the loss. "They didn't need to be there. I was graduating, and technically they were done with me. I wasn't going to be paying tuition the next semester," she says. "I realized that I was way more than a number — I was a part of something so much greater."

Reminding young alumni like Gutierrez how important they are to the university community is a priority for Alumni Programs. That's how initiatives like the Young Alumni Council began. The council helps plan and promote events, programs and services targeted to those who earned their degrees in the last 10 years. It's a big job — almost half of the university's graduates are considered young alumni, and nearly 1,000 new graduates join the ranks each year.

But between networking and reconnecting, Gutierrez says young alumni have a responsibility.

"It is our charge to give back so that more people can experience what we did at St. Edward's," she says.

For those who think they can't afford it, she issues this challenge: "Cut out one trip to the coffee shop a week, and suddenly you will find an extra \$240 a year that can go straight to St. Edward's. Challenge yourself and you will realize, as I did, that you can give a lot more than you might think."

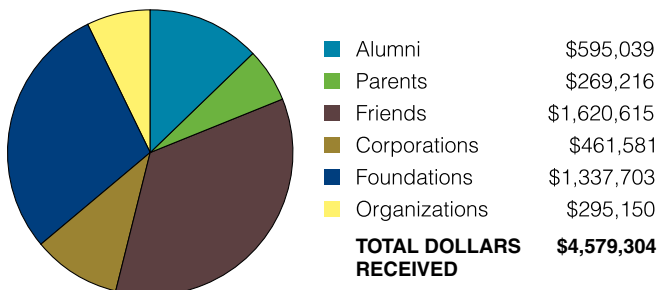

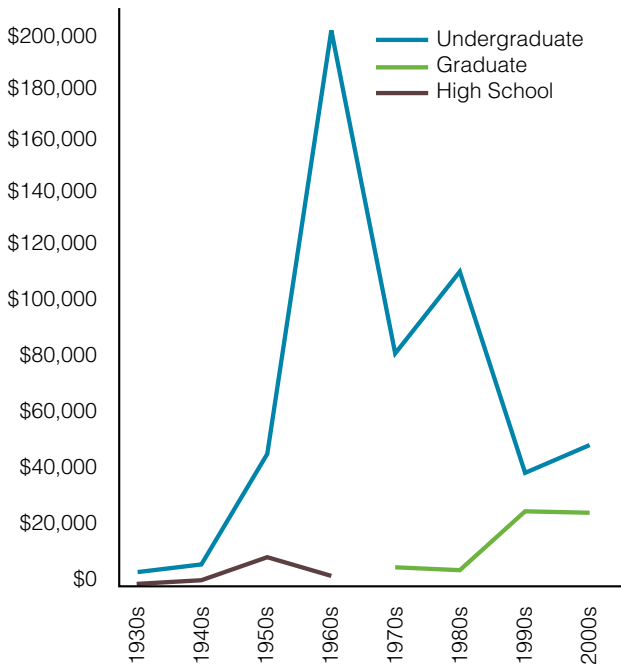
